

Call for Applications: Student Fellowship (Multimedia)

The Think Tank offers Student Fellow positions and internships to work with the MacroPolo team on extensive research and writing projects, digital content and products, and technical and multimedia efforts. These are great opportunities to join an energetic and entrepreneurial team to help build a leading platform on China's political economy.

Although general research is required, Student Fellows also have the chance to lead on significant projects and potentially co-publish substantial work. Previous cohorts have worked on investment case studies and supported product launches for MacroPolo. Currently, we are seeking one student fellow to help with preliminary research on a new multimedia project.

The Student Fellows program is conducted in partnership with the University of Chicago and is available to applicants who are currently enrolled at either the undergraduate or graduate level. Internships are available to all applicants and are dependent on specific needs, projects, and qualifications.

For the current opening, qualified applicants should have excellent research and writing skills, and a demonstrable interest in economics/finance, political science, policy, or other social sciences. Previous experience with journalism, especially in multimedia, is preferred, but not necessary. Familiarity with China and Chinese language is a plus, but not required. The part-time internship starts in mid-March.
